These containers will be located near the green recycling bins behind the maintenance building at Graytown Park. You may bring items between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm and unloading assistance will be available with just a backhoe, no human touch. Absolutely no items dropped off early or late.

This annual trash collection service is provided for Benton Township residents only. **Proof of residence** will be required. Not intended for business or commercial use. Unload your own trash with help of loaders

Acceptable Items Include:

Predominately-Metal Items: All Appliances, Microwaves, Air Conditioners, Engines, Bicycles, Lamps, Empty Paint Cans, and Scrap Metal

Batteries are accepted but must be kept separate!

Household Trash: Non-recyclable Glass and Plastics, Rinsed Pesticide Containers, Buckets, Light Bulbs, Cookware, Mirrors, Ceramics, Toys, and Misc. Junk.

Items that will NOT be accepted include liquids, paint, garbage, yard waste, building materials, tires, and hazardous materials. NO Mattresses, NO Chemical Shuttle Totes

Recycle the following items in the green recycling container: Newspapers, Magazines, Corrugated Cardboard, Glass Jars, #1 & #2 Plastic Bottles, and Steel & Aluminum Cans.

NO early drop offs accepted, metal containers will be present
